

The tightening torque values for screw connections must be observed to the letter. If no tightening torque values are given, they are to be taken from the Technical Information System (TIS). ◀







g	MI fire extinguisher	1


2. To install the fire extinguisher








Check the position of the scribed point by putting the holder **c** in place. When you do this, the fastening holes for the holder **c** must line up with the centre point of the front securing screw and the scribed point. ◀




Punch the scribed point, drill a pilot hole through the side trim (2) and the body panel with a \varnothing 3 mm bit (1) then drill the final hole with a \varnothing 7.1 mm bit.




Remove both screws (1) and the cover (2) of the left side trim in the boot (3).

2. To install the fire extinguisher






Clamp a suitable spacer (1) between the body panel (2) and the side trim (3) so the distance between the hole (4) drilled in the body panel and the hole (5) drilled in the side trim is about 10 mm. Drill out the hole (5) in the side trim using a Ø 13 mm bit, taking care not to damage the Ø 7.1 mm hole drilled in the body panel. Deburr the edges of both holes. Also deburr the inside of the Ø 7.1 mm hole drilled in the body panel and treat it with the anti-corrosion measures set out in BMW specifications. Release the clamping effect by removing the spacer (1). Fit back on the rear screw and the cover of the left side trim in the boot.




Use the riveter for blind rivets with internal threads (1) to insert the sealing blind rivet with internal thread **e** into the hole drilled in the body panel.



Connect the tensioning strap $\bf b$ to the holder $\bf c$ and make sure that the positioning pin (1) of the tensioning strap $\bf b$ engages in the hole in the holder $\bf c$.

Use the positioning pin (2) of the holder **c** to align the holder **c** and the tensioning strap **b** in the direction of the rear seat backrest (3) at both screw connection points. Tighten the front screw connection point of the holder **c** using the self-tapping screw **d**. Tighten the rear screw connection point of the holder **c** using the fillister head screw **f**, tightening torque 2.5 Nm.



Fit the fire extinguisher **a** onto the holder **c** with its handle pointing towards the rear sear backrest (1). Make sure that the positioning pin (2) of the holder **c** engages in the hole in the fire extinguisher A. Put on the tensioning strap **b** and close the clasp (3). When you close the clasp (3), make sure that you hear both locking bars engage.
