

# Heated spray jets retrofit kit MINI (R50)

The installation time is approx. 1.5 hours, but this may vary depending on the condition of the car and the equipment in it.

#### Important information

The retrofit kit is only for use within the dealership organisation.

Do not kink or damage the cables during the installation work since otherwise they may cause faults that can later only be identified by extensive additional work. The costs incurred as a result of this will not be reimbursed.

If the specified PIN chambers are occupied, bridges, double crimps or twin-lead terminals must be used.

#### **Target group**

The target group for these installation instructions is specialist personnel trained on MINI cars with specialist knowledge of vehicle electrical systems.

#### Work:

All servicing, repair and installation work on MINI cars is completed at your own risk. All work is to be carried out using current MINI

- Repair manuals
- Circuit diagrams

in a rational order using the prescribed tools (special tools) and observing current health and safety regulations.



# 1. Preparations

Disconnect the negative pole of the battery	12 00
The following components must be removed first of all:	
Bonnet insulation mat	
Door sill strip, left	
Oddments box under the steering wheel	
Undo the fuse holder II on the left A pillar	

# 2. Installation and cabling diagram



- 5 Joint connector X1108


# 3. Heated spray jets wiring harness connection diagram




# 4. To install the heated spray jets



Replace the existing spray jets (1) with the enclosed heated spray jets.

#### 5. To install and connect the heated spray jets wiring harness






Lay the wiring harness **A** along the bonnet as shown to the left bonnet hinge (1) and secure it with the enclosed cable ties (2).



On cars with a headlight cleaning system the wiring harness **A** is to be secured with cable ties to the spray water hose. ◀




Lay the wiring harness **A** on to the rubber grommet (1) in the left bulkhead.

Lay branches **A3** and **A4** through the rubber grommet (2) into the interior and from there to fuse holder II.




Ensure that the cable is laid in the form of a loop approx. 100 mm long (2) in the wing. ◀



Disconnect the white 12-pin plug **X10204** from the fuse box II (1) and connect branch **A3**, to **PIN 10**. Reconnect plug **X10204** to the fuse box II (1).



If **PIN 10** on plug **X10204** is occupied, branch **A3** must be connected using the enclosed miniature connector. ◀



Connect branch A4 to joint connector X1108.




If all the slots on joint connector **X1108** are occupied, proceed as follows:

- -Connect branch **A4** to the enclosed 3-pin joint connector casing **B2**.
- -Disconnect any brown cable from the joint connector **X1108** and connect it to the enclosed joint connector casing **B2**.
- -Connect branch **B1** to the cleared slot in joint connector **X1108**. ◀

# 6. Coding


Retrofitting the heated spray jets is **not** coding relevant and **cannot** be diagnosed.

# 7. Concluding work



- Assemble the car again following the instructions to dismantle it in reverse order.
